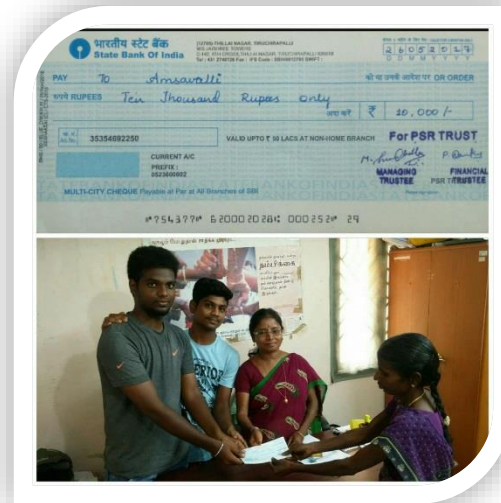

As per our mission, educational support was provided without any negotiations for those who solicit help from us.

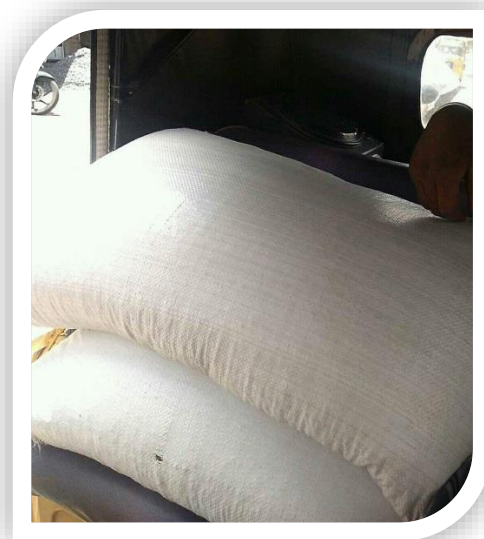

The special day for children in which series of events are conducted to cherish the day and meals also provided for them.

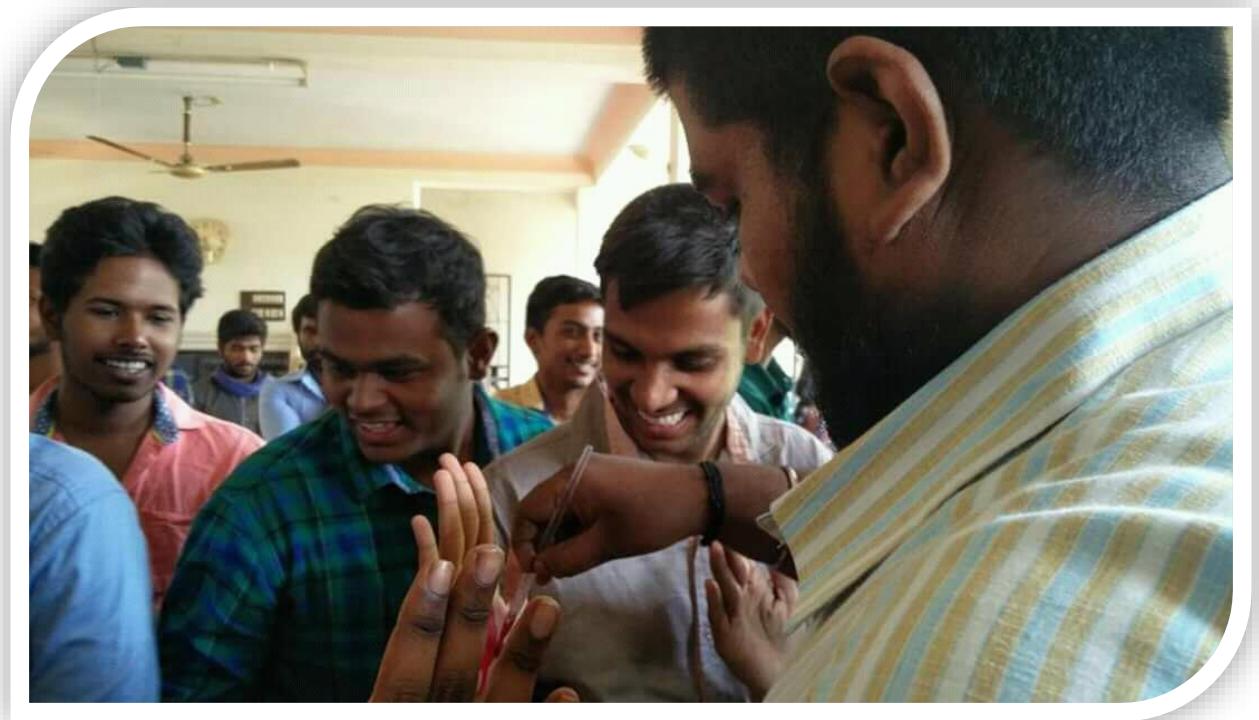




World HIV day

The event conducted with discordant couples and concordant couples by conducting various activities to express the bond between them thereby encouraging them to live along with society.

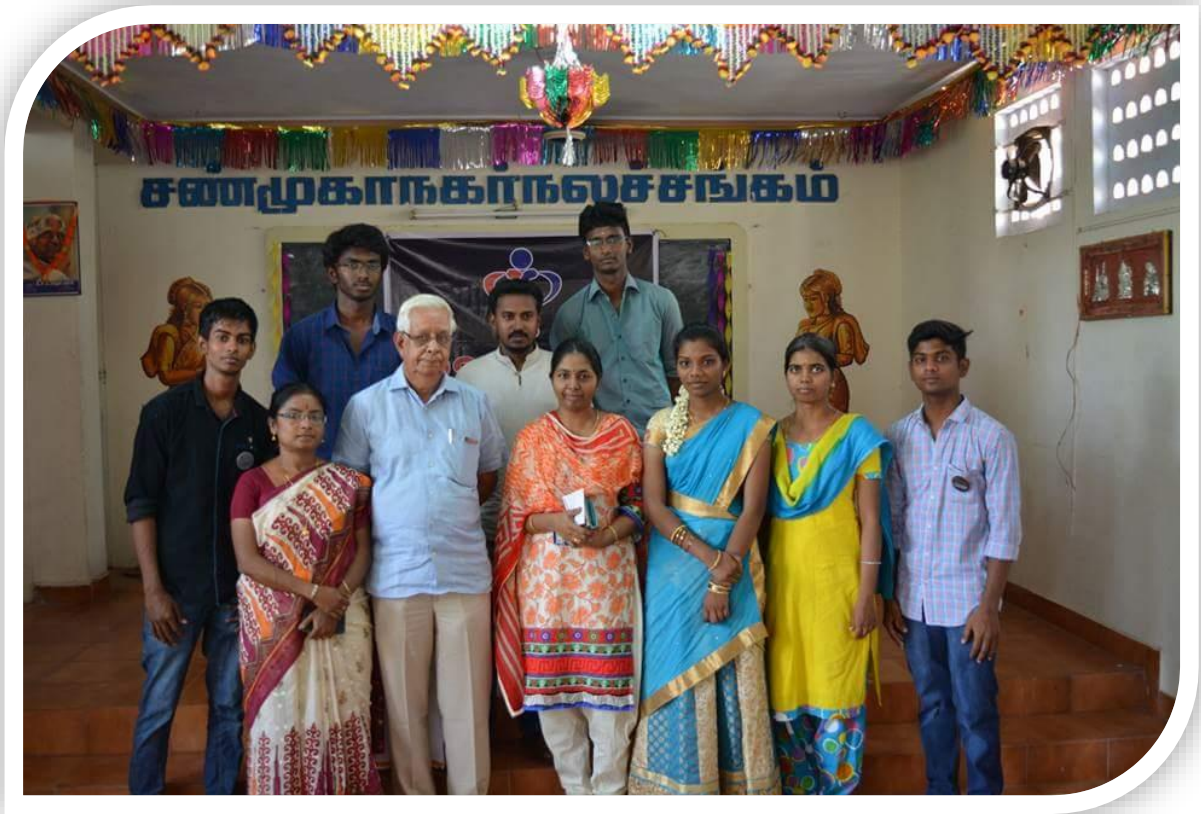




Women's Day
